Psychology - Pure craziness?

From 'Truth Has No Agenda,' September 8, 2013, Professor Wilhelm Wundt of Leipzig University, 1879, experimented on human's senses and declared man's thoughts, personality, and behavior are nothing more than chemical reactions in the brain. He was frustrated because he was unable to change behavior. He generated the idea that man is an animal without a soul, to be trained; not to be a thinker, but to be trained. People from around the world gathered to hear Wundt teach that man is a soulless organism. The age was summed up by Philosopher Friedrich Nietzche, 1882, "God is dead. God remains dead. And we have killed him." My simple rhetorical question to Wundt and Nietzche is, "Did anyone tell God?"
